

### Objective

 To develop guidance on Good Practices of Drug Utilization in the African and Latin American regions to bring them to a higher level of sophistication in order to plan, conduct and evaluate DU research with the final goal of improving the rational use of medicines.



### ISPE DU GUIDANCE FOR AFRICA

#### Current Status:

- Guidance has been finalized
- Two abstracts\* were submitted to ISPE and accepted as poster presentations (Prague, Aug 2018)
- Four manuscripts are planned:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> manuscript focused on LatAm was finalized and it is <u>under</u> review by ISPE Committees
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> manuscript is under review by the <u>small group of coauthors</u>
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> manuscript is <u>under preparation</u>
  - 4<sup>th</sup> manuscript (Guidance) has been finalized, and it will be submitted to the ISPE Committees for review

### Goal and Objective


- Goal: To develop a Pharmacoepidemiology (PE) Survey
   Questionnaire for the Latin American (LatAm) and African Regions
   to contribute with the <u>capacity building</u> of PE in those regions
- Objective: <u>To identify the current status</u>, <u>needs</u>, <u>gaps and priorities</u> of <u>pharmacoepidemiology in the LatAm and African Regions</u>
- Design: Cross-sectional Study
- Method:
  - Two surveys: Survey 1 Target Population
     Survey 2 (Part 1&2)– Current status, needs, gaps & priorities
  - Electronic surveys: English, Spanish, French & Portuguese (translation & reviewed by 2-3 experts in PE)
  - Pilot Testing

#### **Inclusion Criteria**:

- HCP from academic institutions, government, industry, other
- Pharmacovigilance, pharmacoepidemiology or both
- LatAm & African regions


